CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry

Course overview:

The unit CPCCOHS1001A Work safely in the construction industry is the unit of competency, which has been developed to meet the requirements of the National Code of Practice for Induction for Construction Work. Also known as White Card (or formerly Green Card) this course provides a basic introduction to Work Health & Safety in order to work safely in the construction industry. Swetha International Pty Ltd is a registered training organisation and approved by SafeWork NSW to deliver General Construction Industry Induction.

Learning Outcomes:

Participants will gain the following skills and knowledge at the end of course and will be able to:

- Identify WHS legislative requirements
- Identify construction hazards and control measures
- Identify WHS communication and reporting processes
- Identify WHS incident response procedures.

Up on successful completion of training participants will receive a Statement of Attainment for CPCCOHS1001A Work Safety in the Construction Industry.

Participants will be issued with a Statement of Training (SOT) on the day of successful completion. The SOT is valid for a period of 60 days pending the issue of the WorkCover GIT card.

Who can enrol?

- New entrants in the construction workforce
- Workers, supervisors and managers working in construction, but do not have the White Card
- Individuals who will undertake housing or construction work in the near future.
- Participants must be 14 years and or over



Program Schedule: Wednesdays 0900 to 1600 (Other Week day, weeknight and weekend sessions available for 10+ bookings)

Attendance of 6 hours of face-to-face learning and completion of assessment tasks is mandatory in order to complete this unit of competency. Six (6) hours of face-to-face learning does not include breaks.

You will be required to arrive at 8.00 am to register for the course, complete all paperwork and provide your 100 point ID.

The training is conducted at Swetha International Pty Ltd training rooms at:

Requirement for attending Training:

To attend training on the day you must:

- **Have confirmed enrolment details and paid the course fee**
- **Bring a pen to take notes and complete the assessment**
- **Provide 100 point proof of ID on arrival by presenting original photographic evidence of:**
 - **Photo, Date of Birth, Signature, Current Address**
- **wear appropriate clothing to be able to perform in group activities and demonstrations**

Please note that as you should allow up to 60 days for issue of GIT card, a Statement of Training is issued to successful participants on the day with validity of 60 days.

Participants must provide payment, a **completed enrolment form and USI number** before training day.

Assessment

Learning and assessment activities will be conducted by assessors using a range of evidence gathering techniques throughout the course, including written, observations, case studies, scenarios and practical demonstrations. Your trainer will provide you with any support you may require with your assessments throughout your training.

If you are assessed as "Not yet competent" on the first attempt, you will be given another opportunity to demonstrate your competence. If you are still not successful after this you may need to reenroll and repeat the unit of work.

Pathways

There are several pathways available to you after successful completion of this unit. You could either choose to complete CPC10111 Certificate I in Construction or choose to enrol in an apprenticeship or other training program. Please ask one of our friendly staff for further information.

Pre-requisites

There are no pre-requisites or co-requisites units of competency for this course however as this course requires you to read, write and communicate in English, you must demonstrate adequate English language skills.
